### **Time Commitments:**

Zone Gathering: (*your monthly zone meeting details*), you/your proxy if you are unavailable (monthly)

Annual Lifegroup Leader Gathering: All Zone Lifegroup Leader start of the year gathering (once a year)

### **Roles:**

- Pray for Lifegroup community
- Model discipleship & help others be committed to discipleship
- Lead Lifegroup to share responsibilities that ensure healthy Lifegroup community
- Connect with guests within 48 hours of contact
- Submit Lifegroup Leader Feedback, as requested
- *Sunday Ministry Team (optional)*

### **Expectations:**

- Commit to spend regular daily time with Jesus
- Commit to walk in purity
- Commit to Biblical lifestyle
- Commit to ownership at Antioch: be committed to relationship with Jesus (saved and baptized), be committed to doctrinal beliefs of Antioch, be committed to tithe, be committed to Lifegroup community, be committed to being a pillar
- Commit to discipleship lifestyle: involved in discipleship and helping people in your Lifegroup get involved in discipleship relationships
